HOW TO REGISTER:

1. Complete a separate registration card for each student. Correct pre-printed information on registration card as necessary. Grade indicated on card is student grade level for the 2010-11 school year.
2. Staple your check, made payable to IPSF-SEP, to the registration card. No cash will be accepted. Use one check per class, per child. Also be sure to note the class name and class identification number (class ID # is found next to the class name on the registration card) and your child's first and last name in memo section of check.
3. There is a \$30.00 registration fee for students who are not enrolled as IUSD students or not Irvine residents. This fee covers immunization and administrative fees. Please add this to your total at time of registration. Note: incoming IUSD kindergarten students who live within IUSD attendance boundaries are not required to pay the \$30 registration fee.
4. Staple your check to the signed and fully-completed registration card and return to your student's school no later than Friday, April 30, 2010. Classes are filled on a first come, first served, basis, as registration cards and full payment is received. Any registration card received after May 3rd will be date-stamped and students will be placed in classes only as space permits.
5. Please write down or make a copy of your child's registration card so that you can refer to it for the dates, times, locations and classes you have signed your child up for this summer.
6. There will be no registration at the district office or at the school sites the day summer school starts
7. If there is any additional information that you would like your child's teacher to know in order to provide a safe and effective educational experience, please feel free to attach an explanation to your child's registration card.

CONFIRMATION OF ENROLLMENT AND LOCATION:

Parents of students enrolled in summer classes will receive a verification email to confirm their child's enrollment by May 21st. Updated instructor and class location information will be available to parents of existing IUSD students through the Parent Portal (<https://myiusd.org/>) after June 18th. You will also be contacted if there is a cancelation or change in location of a class you signed up for. Please do not call school sites.
